==== HACK =====

In /modules/system/blocks/system\_blocks.php  
around line 56, you will find the following line:

```
$form->addElement(new XoopsFormDhtmlTextArea(_MB_SYSTEM_CONTENT,  
'options[0]', htmlspecialchars($ts->stripSlashesGPC($options[0]), ENT_QUOTES), 15,  
60));
```

Change it to:

```
$theEditor = new XoopsFormWysiwygTextArea(array());  
$theEditor->setName('options[0]');  
$form->addElement($theEditor);
```

=====

That's pretty much it.
