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\_ authentication system. It allows to delegate authentication to directory server like **OpenLDAP**, **Microsoft Active Directory**, **Novell e-directory**, **Fedora Directory serveur**, **etc**, ....

XOOPS also makes it possible to fill automatically XOOPS database from the directory server (provisionning)
